ORAL ORDER

2 05-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel representing the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is looking for a direction to the respondent no.2 to decide the appeal bearing Appeal Case No.75 of 2014 pending with the respondent no.2 and to pass final order in terms of Section 127 of the Electricity Act, 2003. It is stated that the appeal is



pending before the respondent no.2 for last five years now.

Learned counsel for the respondents have no objection to the issuance of a direction to the respondent no.2 to dispose off the appeal within a reasonable period.
