APP for the State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case registered under Section
304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is that the accused persons including the
petitioners caused death of the daughter of the informant due to
non-fulfilment of demand of dowry.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the
petitioners are in custody since 06.11.2018 and have got no
criminal antecedent. Charge sheet has been submitted in this
case. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged
against the petitioners. The petitioners have falsely been



implicated in the present case. The petitioner No.1 is the father-in-law and petitioner No.2 is the mother-in-law of the deceased. They are separate in mess and property from the husband of the deceased. The husband of the deceased is in custody.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioners are named in the complaint case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M., Sherghati (Gaya) in connection with Barachatti (Mohanpur) P.S. case No.683 of 2018.
