2 08-03-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Petitioner is in custody in connection with Jamui
Adarsh P.S. Case No. 676 of 2018 for the offence under sections
272 of the Indian Penal Code and sections 30/30(A) of Bihar
Excise Prohibition (Amendment) Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

In the instant case total 375 of liters of liquor was
seized.

Learned counsel submits that nothing was recovered
from the conscious possession of the petitioner rather it was
recovered from the Tempo and petitioner is said to be the driver
of the said Tempo.



Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 5.1.2019, let the petitioner, named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Addl. District and Sessions Judge-2nd, Jamui, in connection with Jamui Adarsh P.S. Case No. 676 of 2018.
