3 15-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

Petitioner, who is in custody, seeks bail in
connection with Mohiuddin Nagar P.S. Case No. 167 of 2017
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 304-B of
the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner has earlier moved this Court for bail vide
Cr. Misc. No. 34726 of 2018 which was rejected on 21.08.2018
with a liberty to renew his prayer for bail after completion of
one year in custody. Petitioner is in custody since 06.11.2017.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances
of the case and the observation made in order dated 21.08.2018



passed in Cr. Misc. No. 34726 of 2018, petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.D.J.-III, Samastipur in connection with S.Tr. No. 196 of 2018 arising out of Mohiuddin Nagar P.S. Case No. 167 of 2017 with following conditions:

- (1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.
- (2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and his absence on two consecutive dates without proper and valid reason trial court shall have liberty to cancel his bail bond.
- (3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
