ORAL ORDER

2 25-02-2019 Counsel for the petitioner is permitted to implead the Commissioner, Patna Division, as respondent No. 5.

Heard learned Counsel for the petitioner and the learned Counsel for the respondent State.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be filing an appeal before respondent No. 5, the Commissioner, Patna Division, Patna.

In view of the said submission and since adequate, alternative and efficacious remedy is available to the petitioner under the Bihar CCA Rules 2005 the writ petition is disposed of. If the petitioner files his appeal within four weeks, respondent No. 5 would be obliged to consider the same on merits without



raising the issue of the same being filed by delay having regard to the time spent in the instant proceeding.

The writ petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid direction. The appeal of the petitioner should be disposed of by a reasoned and speaking order by respondent No. 5 within a period of three months from the date of its filing.
