APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in **Amarpur P.S. Case No.573 of 2018** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 25(1-b)a, 26, 27 of the Arms Act.

It is alleged in the written report that one country made pistol and 11 live cartridges have been recovered from possession of the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that Petitioner is in custody since 02.11.2018 having clean antecedents.

Keeping in view clean antecedents of the petitioner as well as period of custody, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with



two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka**, in connection with **Amarpur P.S. Case No.573 of 2018**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.

Further, (i) the petitioner will remain present on each and every date of trial, (ii) His absence on two consecutive date(s) without any reasonable cause will make his bail bond liable to be cancelled, and (iii) the petitioner will not intimidate the witnesses in any way and will not hamper the trial.
