counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in connection with Karja P.S. Case No.15 of 2019, registered for the offence punishable under Section 30 (A) of Bihar Excise Amendment Act, 2016.

Allegation has been made that about 15 liters of foreign liquor was recovered from the house of the petitioner, however, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner and he has no criminal antecedent.

Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above-named, be released on anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned



Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Special Judge Excise Act, Muzaffarpur in connection with Karja P.S. Case No.15 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure with a further condition that if the petitioner, after his release in this case, is again found involved in similar nature of cases then the concerned court would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of his bail bonds.
