2 26-03-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Khodwanpur (Chhaurahi O.P.) P.S. Case No. 202 of 2018 for the
offences under Sections 25(1-b)a, 26 and 35 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since
10.09.2018. He further submits that allegation against the
petitioner is that one pistol was recovered from the possession
of the petitioner.

Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal
antecedent and he is remained in custody for more than six
months, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, let
the petitioner, named above, be released on bail on furnishing



bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate at Begusarai in connection with Khodwanpur (Chhaurahi O.P.) P.S. Case No. 202 of 2018.
