2 26-03-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP representing the State.

Petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in connection
with Jamui Mahila P.S. Case No. 77 of 2018 registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 323, 341, 313 and 498(A) of
the I.P.C. and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioners happen to be the in-laws of the informant and



they have falsely been implicated in this case because they are relations of the husband of the informant. There is general and omnibus allegation of assault for non-fulfilment of demand of dowry.

Learned APP for the State is present and has opposed the prayer for bail.

In the given facts and circumstances of the case wherein these petitioners are said to be in-laws and allegedly made accused because they happen to be the relations of the husband of the informant as also that the FIR has been lodged after four months of the alleged occurrence on 15.07.2018, in case of arrest or surrender of the petitioners within a period of four weeks from today, the abovenamed petitioners shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.15,000/- (rupees fifteen thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Jamui in connection with Jamui Mahila P.S. Case No. 77 of 2018, subject to the condition prescribed under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
