ORAL ORDER

2 29-03-2019 The prayer which the petitioner is seeking in this writ application is peculiar for issuance of writ of certiorari quashing 'General Power of Attorney' executed by respondent No.5 in favour of respondent No.4, whereby he is said to have authorized him to sell such property which does not exclusively belong to respondent No.5. The nature of relief which the petitioner is seeking cannot be entertained in a proceeding under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

This application is dismissed.



The petitioner shall have liberty to take recourse to appropriate provision of law, raising his claim as has been raised in the present writ application.
