ORAL ORDER

2 03-04-2019 This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises

out of Complaint Case No. 216 of 2018, disclosing offences

under Section 498A of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner happens to be husband of the complainant

and allegation against him is of subjecting the complainant to

cruelty with respect to demand of dowry.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is

that earlier the petitioner was kidnapped and he was forcibly got

married with the complainant for which, he has also lodged a

case and the entire allegation is false and concocted.

Learned counsel for the State as well as learned

counsel for the complainant opposed the prayer for bail.



Having heard both sides, considering the submission, as above, this application is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned SdJM, West Muzaffarpur, in connection with Complaint Case No. 216 of 2018, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
