Nobody appears on behalf of the petitioner. Learned
counsel for the State and learned counsel for the opposite party no.
2 have assisted the Court.

2. The petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Complaint Case No. 1218(C) of 2016 dated 18.04.2016 instituted
under Sections 376 and 323 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The allegation against the petitioner in Complaint
Case No. 1218(C) of 2016 dated 18.04.2016, is of having married
the opposite party no. 2 but thereafter, turning her out of the



matrimonial home and terming the marriage to be a drama and also disowning the marriage.

4. Learned APP and learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2 submitted that there is a certificate and affidavit of both the parties in support of such marriage which has not been denied to be forged and fabricated by the petitioner.

5. Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and submissions of learned counsel for the parties, the Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the application stands dismissed.
