3 21-06-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 399,402,414 of the Indian
Penal Code and 25(1-b)a, 26,35 of Arms Act.

From the possession of the petitioner, country
made pistol and cartridges were recovered. Petitioner has got
criminal antecedent. He is in custody since 12.08.2018.
Investigation of the case is already complete.

Submission is that co-accused-Deepak Kumar
Singh has already been allowed bail by a Coordinate Bench of
this Court in Cr. Misc. No. 3799 of 2019.

Considering the nature of allegation and
criminal antecedent of the petitioner, I am not inclined to



enlarge him on bail for the present in connection with Bidupur P.S.Case No.301 of 2018 pending in the court of learned A.C.J.M.-14, Vaishali at Hajipur. Hence, prayer is refused.

However, petitioner may renew his prayer for bail if the trial is not concluded within six months from the date of framing of the charge. Prayer for bail shall be considered by the learned court below without being prejudiced by this order.
