4 21-08-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Dhanarua P.S. Case No. 168 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable under Section 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioner no.1 is the married Nanad of the deceased and petitioner no.2 is the unmarried daughter of petitioner no.1. Learned counsel for the petitioners has further submitted that the husband of the deceased is in jail custody since 29.05.2018.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the



above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Masaurhi, Patna in connection with Dhanarua P.S. Case No. 168 of 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
