3 03-06-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Bimlesh Manjhi, the son of the informant, had
gone to his matrimonial house and there he died in unnatural
circumstances. Allegation is that he was murdered by throttling
by the inlaws including the petitioner. The Doctor has found a
case of hanging which caused fracture of trachea and respiratory
arrest. There is no eye witness of the occurrence nor there is any
motive for commission of murder of Bimlesh Manjhi.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the
petitioner, above named, who is father-in-law of Bimlesh



Manjhi, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Jehanabad Police Station Case No.352 of 2018, subject to the condition that both bailors shall be resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below and further the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
