State.

The petitioner being the husband of the informant, apprehending his arrest in connection with Begusarai Mahila P.S. Case No.30 of 2018, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 504, 379, 313, 498A of the Indian Penal Code and $\frac{3}{4}$ of Dowry Prohibition Act.

The prosecution case, as per the written report of Priti Singh, submitted to the S.H.O. Begusarai Mahila P.S. is to the effect that the marriage of the informant was performed with the petitioner on 16.02.2015 but subsequent to the marriage, further demand of dowry of Rs. 6 lakh was made and due to non-fulfillment of the same, torture was inflicted upon the informant by the petitioner and other in laws family members.



Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner admits his marriage with informant and he is ready to keep the informant as wife with full dignity and honour, statement to that effect has been made in paragraph no.11 of the petition, which reads as follows :-

“11. That the petitioner is ready to keep the informant with full honour and dignity..”

Considering the present stand of the petitioner, let the above named petitioner be released on provisional anticipatory bail for six months in the event of arrest / surrender before the learned Court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Begusarai, in connection with Begusarai Mahila P.S. Case No.30 of 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.

Let the learned Court below issue notice to the informant and on her appearance, the petitioner will take the informant to keep her as wife with full dignity and honour.

The provisional bail of the petitioner will be confirmed by the learned Court below in three eventualities, (i) if the matrimonial harmony is substantially restored, or (ii) if the



informant fails to appear before the learned Court below, or (iii)
if the informant deliberately gets reluctant to reconcile the issue.
