learned counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in connection with Tharthari P.S. Case No. 02 of 2019, registered for the offence under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 7 of the E.C. Act.

Allegation has been made that the petitioner was selling the fertilizers more than the fixed price.

Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, let the above-named petitioner be released on anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand



Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the A.C.J.M., Hilsa, Nalanda, in connection with Tharthari P.S. Case no. 02 of 2019 subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure. Further condition is that whenever the police will call the petitioner for the purposes of investigation and interrogation, he will remain present for the investigation. In the event of being absent on two consecutive dates without reasonable explanation, the present order will be treated to have been cancelled.
