counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Petitioners are in custody in connection with Nanpur
P.S. Case No. 06/19 for the offence under sections 272, 273/34
of the Indian Penal Code and 30(A) of Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that
petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

In the instant case total 17.640 liters of liquor was
seized. The petitioners are in custody since 6.1.2019.

Learned counsel submits that only on suspicion



petitioners have been made accused in the instant case.

Considering the fact that petitioners have no criminal antecedent, let the petitioners, named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of A.D.J.-II-cum-Special Judge Excise Act, Sitamarhi, in connection with Nanpur P.S. Case No. 06/19.
