ORAL ORDER

4 14-05-2019 This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Katihar Town P.S. Case No. 828/18, disclosing offences under Sections 302, 307 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Prosecution case is that while the informant and his brother and when they reached near the temple 20-25 persons armed with various weapons surrounded them and one of the co-accused, namely, Doma @ Ranjan Paswan fired which hit on the chest of brother of the informant, who died at Sadar hospital, Katihar.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioners is that no specific allegation has been attributed to the petitioners



rather specific allegation has been attributed to the co-accused
Doma@ Ranjan Paswan.

Learned counsel for the State opposed the prayer for
bail, however, he could not controverted the fact that specific
allegation of firing on the brother of the informant is attributed
to Doma @ Ranjan Paswan.

Having heard both sides, in view of the above facts,
this application is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, in
the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below
within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of
Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five Thousand) each with two
sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned
Chief Judicial Magistrate, Katihar, in connection with Katihar
Town P.S. Case No. 828/18, subject to the condition laid down
under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
