Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the
offences punishable under Sections 323/324/504/498A/34 of
the Indian Penal Code.

This is a case under Section 498A of the IPC.

Submission is that the wife is already dead. Hence,
there is no purpose to keep the petitioner behind the bar.

Considering the aforesaid fact, let the petitioner,
above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of
Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like
amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 6th Additional



Chief Judicial Magistrate, Danapur, in connection with Complaint Case No.1270 of 2009, with condition that petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
