APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 342, 370, 384/34 of the Indian Penal Code, Bounded Labour Abolition Act, 1976 and Child Labour (Prohibition & Regulation) Act, 1986.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he induced the parents of 21 minor children to allow them to go to work in Bangle Factory at Jaipur.

Submission is that after institution of FIR, the children have already returned. Petitioner is in custody since 04.01.2019. Petitioner has got identical criminal antecedent.

Consideirng the entire facts, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail **after framing of charges or completion of six months of custody** on furnishing bail bond



of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Pakribarawan Police Station Case No. 110 of 2018, with the following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court-below having immovable property.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
