ORAL ORDER

2 18-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The issue raised in the present writ petition is not maintainable under Article 226.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has filed a representation against the illegal and unauthorized act of the SHO concerned and the said representation is pending at the level of the District Magistrate. He submits that the Court may direct the District Magistrate, Patna to take appropriate action on the representation filed by the petitioner.



Without expressing any opinion the writ petition is disposed of with direction to the District Magistrate, Patna, to take appropriate decision on the representation filed by the petitioner and if it is found that SHO concerned has acted unauthorizedly and contrary to the law, corrective measures may be taken to protect the interest of the petitioner.

With the aforesaid, the instant writ petition stands disposed of.
