3 01-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the
offences under Sections 366A and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case in short is that the accused
persons forcibly abducted the daughter of the informant.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 26.2.2019 and has got no
criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of
witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner has
falsely been implicated in the present case. On recovery, the
statement of the victim has been recorded under Section 164
Cr.P.C. in which she has not named this petitioner. The matter
has been compromised between the parties vide Annexure-4 to



the present application.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kaimur at Bhabhua in connection with Bhabua P.S. Case No. 268 of 2018 (POCSO Case No. 47/2018).
