for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case
registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324, 307,
379, 504 of the Indian Penal Code.



The prosecution case, in brief, is that in the backdrop of a dispute due to wages, an altercation took place and in consequence thereof, the accused persons assaulted the informant and others.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioners. The petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case. There is case and counter case between the parties. The injury on the side of the accused has not been explained by the prosecution. The prosecution has not come with clean hands.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioners are named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Jogapatti (Nawalpur) P.S. Case No. 429 of 2018 in connection with learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bettiah, West Champaran, subject to the



conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of
Criminal Procedure.
