learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Piro
P.S. Case No. 247 of 2017 for the offenses under Section 304
of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he was
negligent in driving the vehicle due to which the accident took
place and a school going girl died.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The petitioner is in
custody since 19.12.2018.

Considering the allegation against the petitioner that
he was negligent in driving the vehicle, the Court is inclined to
grant bail to the petitioner. Let the petitioner, above named, be



enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten
Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the
satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-I, Ara
in connection with Piro P.S. Case No. 247 of 2017.
