3 23-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection
with Barbigha P.S. Case No.384 of 2018 for allegedly having
committed the offence under Sections 272, 273 of the Indian
Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
alleged recovery was not from the conscious possession of the
petitioner but from the house which is in joint possession.

Considering the fact that the alleged recovery was not
from the conscious possession of the petitioner, let the
petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender
before the court below within a period of four weeks from the



date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 2nd Additional District & Sessions Judge, Sheikhpura, in connection with Barbigha P.S. Case No.384 of 2018 (Excise Case No.336 of 2018), subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
