Reporter be ignored for the present.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition
& Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation is recovery of 4.71 foreign liquor, 400 ml
Masaledar liquor and 37 litres Mahua liquor from the possession
of the petitioner.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case. It has further been submitted that the recovered liquor does
not belong to the petitioner. Petitioner is in custody since



27.2.2019.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Special Case No. 2210 of 2019 arising out of Alamganj P.R. Case No.238 of 2019, with following conditions:-

(1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.

(2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court.

(3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.

(4) If the petitioner is found involved in similar nature of offences, after his release on bail the trial court shall take steps to cancel his bail bond.
