ORAL ORDER

2 28-03-2019 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Mahila P.S. Case No. 54 of 2018 for the offence under Sections 341, 323, 498(A) and 494/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

The petitioners are father-in-law and mother-in-law of the informant. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners has submitted that it is mainly because of the matrimonial dispute between the informant and her husband that a criminal case has been registered, in which the petitioners have been implicated only because they are father and mother of



the husband of the informant.

Considering the facts and circumstances, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioners above named, in the event of their arrest/surrender within six weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M. I/C, Sitamarhi, in Mahile P.S. Case No. 54 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioners shall present themselves before the Police/Court, as the case may be, as and when required and in the event of failure on their part to appear before the Court on two consecutive occasions, their bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.
