2 01-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in **Samastipur (Town) P.S.**

Case No. 230 of 2018, instituted for the offence under
Section(s) 395 and 397 of the Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is
not named in the written report. There is no recovery from
possession of the petitioner. No Test Identification Parade has
been held. The name of petitioner has come in the confessional
statement of co-accused Md. Kalim. Counsel for the petitioner
further submits that co-accused Sunny Kumar with similar
allegation has already been granted bail by coordinate Bench of
this Court vide order dated 14.02.2019 passed in Cr. Misc.
8866 of 2019.

Petitioner is in custody since 21.09.2018.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of **learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Samastipur**, in connection with **Samastipur (Town) P.S. Case No. 230 of 2018**, subject to the condition that both the bailors will be the close relatives of the petitioner.
