ORAL ORDER

2 10-05-2019 Petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his arrest in connection with Brahampur (K.B) P.S. Case No. 128 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable under Section 30A of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Allegation is of recovery of 4.5 litres of liquor from the husk room of the petitioner.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that recovery has been from the husk room and not from his possession or from his house and possibility of keeping the same by someone else cannot be ruled out and though petitioner has been made accused in five other cases but they are not related to Excise Act.

Heard learned APP also.

In view of above facts and circumstances, let



petitioner, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the receipt of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional District Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Buxar, in connection with Brahampur (K.B) P.S.Case No. 128 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. and further condition is that one of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immoveable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.
