the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Complaint Case No. 13 of 2017 registered for the offence punishable under sections 420, 466, 467, 468, 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. Petitioners are full brothers of the complainant. Moreover, the dispute involved is purely civil in nature. Petitioners are men of clean antecedent.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, IV, Saharsa in connection with Complaint Case No. 13 of 2017 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
