APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 457, 380 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is that unknown thieves committed theft in
the mobile shop of the informant.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 9.1.2019. Charge sheet has
been submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering
of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner has
falsely been implicated in the present case. The petitioner is not
named in the F.I.R. The petitioner had no knowledge that the
mobile in question is stolen property. The petitioner has been
made accused due to mistake of fact. There is no compliance of



Section 100 of Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sri Shidharth Pandey, Judicial Magistrate, 1st class, Daudnagar, District Aurangabad in connection with Haspura P.S. case No.01 of 2019.
