The petitioner seeks bail in **Bishambharpur P.S.**
Case No. 09 of 2019, instituted for the offence under Section(s)
414 of Indian Penal Code and Section 7 of Essential
Commodities Act.

It is alleged in the written report that 100 litres of
kerosene oil has been recovered from the Motorcycle. The
alleged Motorcycle belongs to the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is
