2 28-03-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Petitioner is in custody in connection with Spl. Case
No. 1925/2019, arising out of N.T.P.C. Case No. 11/2019 for the
offence under sections 30(a), 37© of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that
in the instant case 20 liters of liquor.

Learned counsel submits that nothing was recovered
from the conscious possession of the petitioner rather the liquor
was seized on the national highway road.

Learned counsel further submits that seizure list was
not prepared in accordance with the mandatory provisions of
section 100 Cr.P.C.



The petitioner is in custody since 20.2.2019.

Considering the fact that liquor was seized from the road side, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, let the petitioner, named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Spl. Excise Court, Patna, in connection with Spl. Case No. 1925/2019, arising out of N.T.P.C. Case No. 11/2019 subject to the condition that one of the bailors should be elected representative of the local body.
