4 29-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the
offences under Sections 304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of committing
torture and thereafter caused death of the victim due to non-
fulfilment of demand of dowry.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 8.2.2019 and has got no
criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of
witnesses alleged against the petitioner. Charge-sheet has been
submitted in the present case. The petitioner has falsely been
implicated in the present case. The witnesses in paragraphs 80
and 82 of the case diary have categorically stated that the



deceased has committed suicide. Hence, no offence under Section 304B is made out. At best, it is a case for an offence under Section 306 IPC.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Majhauriya P.S. Case No. 130 of 2018.
