3 22-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Turkauliya (Raghunathpur) P.S. Case No. 60 of 2018 for
the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341,
323, 324, 307 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that the petitioner is innocent and has not
committed any offence. In fact, there is land dispute between
the parties and on account of same case and counter case
has been lodged by both the parties. Hence, the petitioner
may be granted the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the



case, let the, above named, petitioner in the event of
surrender within a period of four weeks be released on bail
on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with
two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the
learned C.J.M., East Champaran at Motihari in connection
with Turkauliya (Raghunathpur) subject to the conditions
laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
