2. The petitioners have moved the Court under
Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for the
following relief:

*“That this quashing application is
being filed by the petitioner against the order dt.
11.7.06 passed by Learned Judicial Magistrate
1st Class Jehanabad in Complaint Case No.
532/2005 trial no. 3633/2013 by which order the
Learned Magistrate took cognizance under
Sections 304(B), 201/34 of the I.P.C. and ¾ of
the Dowry Prohibition Act, and directed the
office to issue non bailable warrant of arrest
against the accused persons.”*
