ORAL ORDER

2 18-04-2019 An order, dated 28.12.2018, passed by the Additional Collector, Saran, Chhapra, in Mutation Revision Case No. 28 of 2018, has been put to challenge in the present writ application.

The petitioner has a remedy of filing an application before the Bihar Land Tribunal, Patna, against the impugned order, which is statutory in nature, which the petitioner has not availed.

This application is, accordingly, disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner to approach the Bihar Land Tribunal, Patna, against the impugned order. It is indicated that, if any



question of limitation arises and the petitioner files any application for condonation of delay, the same shall be disposed of, keeping in mind the fact that the petitioner was pursuing his remedy by filing the present writ application.
