ORAL ORDER

2 26-04-2019 The petitioner is seeking a direction to the respondent-Circle Officer, Amarpur, Banka, to dispose of his application for mutation. The said representation has been brought on record by way of Annexure-3 series.

In my view, however, it does not appear whether the petitioner has filed any application for mutation, as contemplated under the Bihar Land Mutation Act, 2011, read with the Bihar Land Mutation Rules, 2012 (in short ‘the Rules’). Chapter-II of the Rules prescribed the manner of filing of a



mutation petitioner in Form 1A, which the petitioner has apparently not done.

This application is, thus, disposed of with the liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate application before the competent authority under the Bihar Land Mutation Act, 2011, for the relief, which the petitioner is seeking.
