2 02-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Ahiyapur P.S. Case No. 680 of 2018 for the offence under Sections 302,201, 109, 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the allegation against this petitioner is that she has relationship with the husband of the victim and co-accused (husband of the victim) was apprehended by the police. Learned counsel for the petitioner next contended that role of this petitioner is that she instigated the husband of the victim to eliminate the victim. He submits that petitioner is in custody since 25.06.2018.



Considering the fact that the petitioner is a lady and she has remained in nearly nine months, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Let, the petitioner named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Addl. District & Sessions Judge, 11th, Muzaffarpur, in connection with Sessions Trial No. 88 of 2019, arising out of Ahiyapur P.S. Case No. 680 of 2018.
