The petitioner is in custody in connection with Gaya
Muffasil P.S. Case No. 31 of 2019 for the offenses under
Sections 413 and 414/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Referring to the
