2 19-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Inarwa P.S. Case No. 18 of 2018 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 353, 448, 504, 506, 325, 511 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that similarly situated co-accused persons have already been allowed bail by this Court vide Cr. Misc. No. 76276 of 2018 on 20.12.2018.



Having considered the above facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Narkatiaganj, West Champaran in connection with Inarwa P.S. Case No. 18 of 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
