APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in **Sirdalla P.S. Case No.300 of
2018** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 30(a) of Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is alleged that 40 litres Nepali liquor has been
recovered from the house of the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that aforesaid
house is joint house.

Petitioner is in custody since 30.09.2018 having clean
antecedents.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of
the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner,
above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of



Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Additional Sessions Judge II cum Special Judge, Nawada**, in connection with **Sirdalla P.S. Case No.300 of 2018**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
