2 18-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and counsel
appearing on behalf of the State.

Petitioner is aggrieved by indecisiveness on the part
of the Licensing Authority in the matter of grant of Arms
licence.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has applied for grant of Arms licence before the
District Magistrate, Nawada on 26.7.2018. But till date no
decision in one or other way has been taken by the District
Magistrate, Nawada.
