Petitioner seeks bail in **Sherghati P.S. Case No.43 of 2019** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 20(b), 22 of the NDPS Act.

In the written report, it is alleged that 6.700 Kg. Ganja plant was recovered from the courtyard of Rampukar Singh.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no recovery of Ganja from possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has been arrested merely on suspicion.

Petitioner is in custody since 06.02.2019.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of



Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Sessions Judge cum Special Judge, NDPS Act, Gaya**, in connection with **Sherghati P.S. Case No.43 of 2019**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
