2 18-04-2019 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by a judgment of the Hon'ble Apex Court rendered in the case of **Mukesh Kumar & Anr. vs. The State of Bihar & Others**, reported in 2017 (5) SCC 383, hence, the respondent no.7 be directed to consider the case of the petitioner in light of the said judgment and take a decision within specified time frame.
