2 03-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioners seek bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

The FIR of the occurrence of robbery is against unknown.

Submission is that petitioners are in custody since 11.11.2018. Investigation of the case is already complete. Petitioners were never put on Test Identification Parade during investigation nor any incriminating article was recovered from their possession.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioners,



above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Alamnagar Police Station Case No. 238 of 2018, with the following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court-below having immovable property.

(b) The petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
