A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case for
the offence registered under Sections 498(A)/34 of the IPC and
4 of the D. P. Act in which cognizance has also been taken under
Sections 498(A)/34 of the IPC and 4 of the D.P. Act.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that the accused
persons including the petitioner tortured the victim due to non-
fulfilment of demand of dowry.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.
There is no allegation of tampering with the witnesses alleged



against the petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case due to petty family dispute. The petitioner is the husband of the victim.

On behalf of the learned counsel for the State, it has been submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R/ complaint case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M. Vaishali at Hajipur, in connection with Complaint Case No. 653 of 2017, Trial No. 2814 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
