counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory
bail in connection with Complaint Case No.788 of 2017,
registered for the offence punishable under Section 498 A of the
Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioner nos. 1 and 2 are the father-in-law and mother-in-law
respectively of the complainant.



Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioners, above-named, be released on anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Patna City, Patna in connection with Complaint Case No.788 of 2017, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
