2 03-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 384, 423, 467 and 120B of
the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the informant opposed the prayer
for bail.

Considering the nature of allegation disclosed in the
FIR, the matter appears to be of civil dispute, hence, let the
petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail
bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two
sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned
Court below where the case is pending in connection with
Jamalpur Police Station Case No. 300 of 2018, with the



following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court-below having immovable property.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
